



Try a Storybikes taster

Andy Hunter leads week long storytelling cycle tours. Next year you can choose between Fife & Kinross, Hadrians Wall, Galloway and Perthshire. Not sure about a whole week? There is still time to join a taster weekend in Fife & Kinross on the **10-11th October**. Stories of the saints will feature during the weekend, but not to the exclusion of piracy, murder, imprisonment and the de'ill!

Meet at Kirkcaldy railway station at 10.00, cycle to Ravenscraig castle for some Kirkcaldy stories, and on down to Dysart for an introduction to St Serf. After coffee in the harbourmaster's house (Andy aims to feed all your senses!) cycle North and West to reach Loch Leven. More on St Serf, and his connection with St Mungo before stopping for lunch at Vane Farm (RSPB). A bird watching interlude is an option at this point.

From here there is an off road path all the way to Kinross, with a further option of a detour to Burleigh castle.

Overnight in Kinross – in the evening everyone can have the opportunity to tell stories, sing, play, or just listen....

On Sunday to Dunfermline. This does involve going over the Cleish hills. The climb will be taken gently - probably walking some of it. It is only a mile and a half, or maybe three quarters, going up hill. Another story or two at the top to reward you for your effort!

Arriving in Dunfermline, you will go to what remains of St Margaret's shrine. The tour will finish here, and options then are stay in Dunfermline for lunch, go home by train, or to cycle home (Andy would be happy to chum anyone cycling back to Edinburgh).

The first day is about 25 miles, and the second less than this - maybe 15. Cost for the weekend, which includes dinner, bed and breakfast, is £75 if sharing a room, or £80 for a single room. Since this is just a one night trip we will carry our own luggage. Cycle hire, with panniers, can be arranged.
